ALL CROPS ARE NOT CREATED EQUAL

Photographic prints come in many standard sizes. Although all images are created by the camera at a 2:3 ratio (just like a 4x6 print), many print sizes do not have a 2:3 ratio.

Depending on the size of your final print, part of the image may be cropped

CROPPING HINTS

Choose photos with a comfortable margin of background around the subjects so that people in large parties may not be cut out

When cropping your own prints on a person in a close-up, avoid cropping at a joint (knee, ankle, elbow, wrist).

WHAT IS THE RIGHT SIZE?

There is no right or wrong answer. It is most important to be guided by the wall space that your prints will occupy then select a size and ratio that meets your requirement.

I am happy to provide any advice about how to crop and display your images. Use this chart to visualize how your images will appear when they are printed at different sizes. Let me know if you want to have a custom print size made for a particular frame.
